COVID 19 Vaccine Update 02/16/2021

Bremo Pharmacy is a vaccinator for the Richmond/Henrico Health Department. The health department assigns who Bremo Pharmacy will be vaccinating. During the month of February, the vast majority of vaccine allocated to our site is being used to give the second dose to all of the healthcare providers and group homes we vaccinated in January. Any additional vaccine we receive is being used to vaccinate residents of group homes and other communal living programs. We do not know when we will move to phase 1b, which includes seniors over 65In the meantime, we are only able to vaccinate a small number of patients who are over the age of 65 if there is extra vaccine leftover from a phase 1a clinic. If we do have extra doses, we are contacting healthcare providers and people over the age of 65 who are on our <u>"extra dose list."</u> This is a list of individuals who are available to come on short notice if there is extra vaccine. We do not have a waiting list for scheduling appointments at this time. If you are in phase 1b, we recommend that you fill out an interest form with your local health department. (See Chart below).
