COVID Vaccine Update 02/13/21

- Bremo Pharmacy is busy administering second doses to all the healthcare providers we vaccinated 4 weeks ago. We are also administering first doses to those living in group homes and other independent living facilities assigned to us by the health department.
- We plan our clinics to keep extra doses to a minimum, but sometimes it is unavoidable. We have been offering these extras to healthcare providers still in need of a vaccine and to some of our patients over 65 but we are close to depleting this list.
- Bremo Pharmacy is developing an extra dose list. This is a list of individuals who would be available to come get vaccinated on short notice if there is an extra dose at the end of a clinic. Healthcare providers and those over 65 can sign up using the 'extra dose link'

• IMPORTANT NOTES:

- We can only vaccinate those who have appointments or those we call for extra doses. We cannot accept walk-ins.
- Being on this list does **NOT** guarantee you a dose.
- Everyone should still register with the local health department
- We will not leave messages if we call. We must find people quickly and will move on to the next person if you do not answer.
- Our pharmacy staff does not have access to the extra dose list so please do not call to inquire where you are on the list. This will prevent us from taking care of our pharmacy patients.
- We are only able to provide extra doses to those who have not yet been vaccinated. If you were vaccinated with your 1st dose at a different vaccine clinic and are in need of a second dose, please contact the location that gave you the 1st vaccine.
- The Health Department is in the process of consolidating all county health department wait lists into one statewide list of people needing vaccine. They will open their new platform on Tuesday, February 16th.
