COVID-19 Vaccine Update 8/14/2021- Third Dose

In accordance with the most recent FDA and CDC recommendations, Bremo Pharmacy is able to offer a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd dose of the **Moderna or Pfizer** COVID-19 vaccine to all eligible patients. The 3rd dose should be given 28 days after a person's second dose of mRNA vaccine if eligible, per CDC recommendations described below

On August 13th 2021, the CDC & FDA approved a third dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for immunocompromised patients.

To summarize their recommendations:

- Those eligible for a 3rd dose include solid organ or stem cell transplant patients, individuals receiving cancer treatment, persons living with HIV, those taking medications that decrease immune response, or anyone with a similar immunocompromising condition.
- People who are not immunocompromised are currently **NOT** eligible to receive a 3rd dose.
- This approval applies to the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines only. There has not been any guidance for those who received the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 vaccine.
- It is recommended that patients receive the same vaccine as their first and second dose unless there is a shortage of a particular product. **Bremo**Pharmacy will not be mixing vaccines at this time, and will be only administering the same vaccine as previously administered for 3rd doses.
