

COVID-19 Vaccine Update 10/15/2021- Booster doses

Bremo Pharmacy is committed to keeping everyone up to date on COVID-19 vaccine recommendations and ensuring vaccine access to all patients.

As of October 15, 2021, Bremo Pharmacy is not able to administer boosters for Moderna and Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 vaccines. At this time, Pfizer is the only booster approved by the FDA and CDC.

See below for a quick update on booster doses:

As of Thursday, October 14th 2021, the advisory committee for the FDA, which is made up of a panel of independent medical experts, recommended a booster dose for the Moderna COVID-19 primary series (ie. first and second doses) for specific groups. Additionally, this committee met today, Friday, October 15, 2021 to discuss recommendations for people that received the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 vaccine.

The next steps in the process for the approval of these recommendations and is for the FDA to make a final approval and for the CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices' (ACIP) to approve these recommendations.

We will continue to send updates as soon as we receive the final recommendations for COVID-19 boosters by the FDA and CDC.
