Bremo also carries CBD products that contain 0% THC. CBD comes in many forms! Options include sublingual oil (under the tongue), gummies, gel capsules, and topicals (creams, ointments, gel). Low-dose Naltrexone for Chronic Pain

Bremo can also provide low-dose naltrexone (LDN), which has been shown to benefit chronic pain conditions. LDN has been studied in patients that suffer from conditions such as fibromyalgia, Crohn's disease, and multiple sclerosis. Typically, naltrexone is prescribed at higher doses, such as 50 to 100 mg, to treat alcohol and opioid dependence. LDN doses range from 1.5 mg to 4.5 mg daily. These low doses are not available commercially, but Bremo can make them for you in our compounding pharmacy with a prescription from your doctor!
